INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS OF THE ANIMAL JUDGING COMPETITION ACCORDING TO FLECKSCORE

Dear participant in the international school competition in Traboch,

to ensure a trouble-free event, we would now like to inform you about the exact competition procedure.

Basic prerequisites:

Every participant requires a smartphone or a tablet with an Internet connection. The assessment is entered into an assessment form on the Internet at www.fleckscore.com and must then be sent to a predefined e-mail address. Please make sure that the accumulator of your technical equipment is well loaded. On site we will provide a WLAN network and announce the access data.

One measuring aid is permitted (a measuring tape, ruler, etc).

Several languages are available at www.fleckscore.com. If your native language is not available, we expect participants to be able to communicate in English at least.

Evaluation:

The prepared cows are rated by me. This professional assessment forms the basis with which each participant is compared. The participant, who deviate the least from the rating of mine will win the Fleckscore competition, in which any deviation from my grade setting means a penalty point.

Please note the following when entering the assessment:

The frame dimensions do not have to be evaluated. Only the individual and overall scores for pelvic inclination, muscularity, foundation and udders are taken into account in the evaluation.

In order to be able to input the assessment, however, an entry must be made for the frame dimensions. We will inform you which measures to enter here.

The colour description and milking behaviour do not need to be recorded.

If you notice any deficiencies in the udder or foundation, please make sure that you enter this according to the fault list (1-minor, 2-major fault), as this affects the overall score.

If you have entered the single grades for the foundation or udder, a grade will be recommended for the total score. You can now change this by up to plus / minus 3 points. However, should the participant agree with the suggested overall score, then this can be accepted without alteration.

Once all the above steps have been completed, the assessment can be sent. If you do not fill in a mandatory section correctly, the system will return you to this section. After correcting the error, it should be possible to send the assessment.

The maximum timing for the assessment of a cow is 10 minutes.
